

Region II Building Safety Scholarship Program

1.0 Purpose of Region II Policy: This policy establishes the process for nominating Building Safety Scholarship candidates to receive scholarship funding to attend approved accreditation programs through community colleges or other approved organizations.

2.0 Criteria for qualification of student applicant: The Nominations and Awards Committee may establish reasonable and operable procedures and qualifications for determining the selection of the student considered as the recipient of the scholarship, provided not in conflict with criteria or guidelines herein stated, and as follows:

2.1 The student applicant shall provide a letter of request along with a sponsorship letter from an ICC Chapter or Code Official within Region II and further, that such Code Official or Chapter shall be an active member of the International Code Council.

2.2 The student applicant shall agree that the use of scholarship funds shall be predicated on his or her enrollment or continuance of education in a recognized and/or accreditation program such as Chemeketa Community College Building Inspection Technology program or WABO Code Official Accreditation Program. The approved fund should be used for such purposes of tuition fees unless otherwise determined by the Committee.

2.3 The applicant should possess qualities of good character and integrity.

2.4 Geographic Restrictions.

- The student applicant must reside within the boundaries of Region II.

2.5 The Scholarship funds may be utilized by a student for continuation to succeeding the first year upon satisfactory academic progress, subject to review by the Committee. The maximum number of years that funds may be granted a student is one (1) year. No applicant shall be prohibited from applying for a scholarship in subsequent years.

2.6 Chosen candidates shall provide a written report of their progress to the Region II board upon completion of the scholarship term.

2.7 There shall be a Maximum of one scholarship award per state within Region II per year with a maximum amount of six hundred dollars (\$600), unless otherwise approved by the Region II Board of Directors and the Budget committee.

2.8 Awards are distributed in accordance with current IRS regulations.

2.9 The primary funding source for this program shall be from program specific promotional sales and ICC education benefit revenues.
