

Region II Military Families Committee

1.0 Purpose of Region II Policy: This policy establishes the role, purpose and procedures for the ICC Region II Military Families Committee.

2.0 Name of Committee: Military Families Committee

3.0 Rules and Procedures:

3.1 Potential candidates for sponsorship to attend an ICC preferred provider, or other recognized or accredited, training program shall provide a letter of support and a sponsor letter from a Region II chapter to the committee a minimum of 30 days prior to the date of the training

3.2 Candidates shall be active duty, retired, disabled or honorably discharged military veterans or the immediate family members of those veterans.

3.3 A maximum of two candidates may be chosen per any calendar year. While nominees may be considered, there is no requirement to nominate any number of nominees within any given year.

4.0 Selection Process: In their selection process, the Nominating Committee shall take into consideration previous military service, support by a Chapter or other code enforcement groups. Selection of the nominees shall be by majority vote of the Committee. The Chairperson shall only vote in case of a tie vote of the Committee.

Chosen applicants shall be presented to the Region II Board of directors for final approval.
