

Region II Code Development Committee

1.0 Purpose of Region II Policy: The purpose of this Region II Policy is to prescribe the Rules of Procedure utilized in the continued development and maintenance of the International Codes (Codes).

2.0 Objectives: The ICC Code Development Process has the following objectives:

- 2.1** The timely evaluation and recognition of technological developments pertaining to construction regulations.
- 2.2** The open discussion of code change proposals by all parties desiring to participate.
- 2.3** The final determination of Code text by public officials actively engaged in the administration, formulation or enforcement of laws, ordinances, rules or regulations relating to the public health, safety and welfare and by honorary members.
- 2.4** The increased participation of all parties desiring to participate through an online submittal and voting process that includes opportunities for online collaboration.

3.0 Intent: The code development committee will consider code change proposals as they effect the Region and develop a recommended voting guide to distribute to the Region II membership. The Committee may develop and submit code change proposals as long as they have been first approved by the Region II Board and follow the submittal guidelines of ICC.
